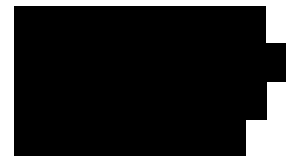
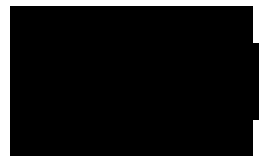
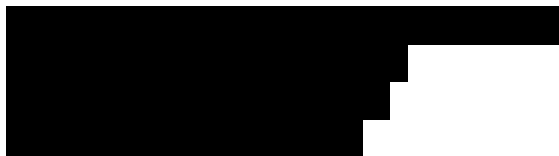
The USAID Office of Inspector General, Africa Regional Office, is initiating an evaluation of the Agency's democracy, stabilization, and governance portfolio in Somalia.
