Audits

Our auditors assess the efficiency and effectiveness of foreign assistance programs that provide food, water, shelter, health care, and other critical aid to people in crisis situations.

Investigations

Our special agents investigate allegations of fraud, corruption, sexual exploitation and abuse, and other misconduct involving foreign assistance programs and operations. Our criminal

investigators work with their local, state, Federal, and international investigative counterparts and prosecutors to bring criminals to justice.


Competitive Salaries and Benefits
