MANAGEMENT LETTER ON OPENLY-SHARED SENSITIVE INFORMATION ON USAID'S IT NETWORK

SEPTEMBER 12, 2014

WASHINGTON, D.C.

This is a summary of our management letter on openly-shared, sensitive information on USAID's IT network.

During the "Audit of USAID's Progress in Adopting Cloud-Computing Technologies" the Office of Inspector General discovered sensitive information on USAID's IT network for which access had not been restricted. Because of the seriousness of the findings, OIG immediately issued a management letter to notify the Agency's Chief Information Officer and Chief Privacy Officer so they could take immediate action.

In response, the Chief Privacy Officer said the Agency had reported the incident to USCERT and begun to take corrective action.
